

“A quite exceptional church”



**Berwick Parish Church** was built in 1650-52, during the government of Oliver Cromwell. It is the only continuing Parish Church which retains significant features from that period and is recognised by Pevsner to be “of quite exceptional architectural interest”. Located a short distance from the town centre, it receives many visitors. A warm welcome is extended to all: those who are interested in the history of the building and those who share the faith of the church. The facilities in the church building and in the adjacent Parish Centre are much used throughout the year, for a variety of local activities as well as for regular worship.

## HOW YOU CAN HELP

The Trust's ongoing support of the church requires it continually to raise money by donations, legacies and lifetime gifts.

At the Trustees' discretion, donations may go towards the upkeep of the church buildings and their contents; the organ; the churchyard and grounds; or the wider work of the church. If you wish, you may specify, in discussion with the Treasurer, for which of the Trust's purposes you wish your gift to be used.



If you are considering alternative ways of remembering the Trust in your Will, you may make a legacy of a specific sum of money, or a bequest of your property, or of the residue of your estate or part of it.

Your solicitor will advise on the best way to assist the Trust in your Will. An existing Will may be amended by a simple codicil to meet your wishes.




## WHO ARE WE?

**Berwick Parish Church Trust** is a registered charity set up in 1986 to help finance the 'restoration, preservation, enhancement and beautification' of Berwick's historic Grade 1 listed Parish Church. The Trust's purpose is to raise money that secures the future of this important place of worship, mission and ministry, and community resource for all the people of Berwick.



## WHAT ARE OUR PROJECTS?

**In the recent past the Trust** has provided funding for many church projects, including rebuilding and modernisation of the fine pipe organ; restoration of the stained-glass windows; replacement and upgrading of the church heating plant; upgrading of facilities in the Parish Centre; and the installation of sound and audiovisual equipment in the church. Currently, the Trust is raising funds to replace the church's 100-year-old roof.



## WHAT DO WE DO?

**The Trust supports** the financial objectives of the Parochial Church Council, the body that runs the affairs of the parish church on a day-to-day basis. Distinct from the Council, it is administered by a group of Trustees made up of church members and other local people. Trustees are advised on investment decisions by external professional consultants, and their policy is to pursue an ethical investment strategy aiming for long term growth. Annual accounts are subject to independent examination.
